Brief description/purpose of the meeting	Dima Al -Khatib requested a meeting with National Traffic Strategy Project Team to provide with feedback/ progress on project tasks /activities status.
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**Points discussed/ raised during the meeting;**

- Dima started the Meeting with a welcome to the attendees.
- Dr. Mubashar attended the meeting for 20 minutes.
- Dr. Mubashar stated that the project is moving steady forward and the budget for this year is \$5.5 m.
- Dr. Mubashar asked about the status of the overseas training at Northwestern University and also asked the MOI team to confirm the dates with the university as soon as they can.
- Col Salem mentioned that as per the contract with Northwestern University it mentions that they need one month notice ahead of the agreed dates and we still have time to confirm the dates for end of July.
- Col. Salem brought to attention the subject of the overseas training delay was because of the issue of the travel tickets and DSA for the 24 police officers and engineers; the cost was supposed to be covered by the project but the GDT officials thought this would be covered from the Ministry as it is mentioned in the official plan of the MOI.
- MOI coordination team send an official letter to the training department for the second time to correct the situation regarding the cost of 70,000 KD for the tickets and DSA which will be included in the total cost covered by the project for the overseas training. The letter is already signed and in the process to be signed by the MOI Undersecretary, and that will be confirmed tomorrow by the COB.
- Dr. Mubashar asked about the procurement status regarding 2015 procurement plan
- Sam answered that all the procurement are following the plan but a majority of the pending procurement is depending on the commencement of the Out-of-Box-Software

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firm as they need to provide input on the specifications of the equipment and the TORs for the related services and that TRL staff are delayed because of long process involved to obtain a visa to Kuwait.

- Dr Mubashar suggested that we can work on more than one task in parallel exploring the possibility of the company starting to work while they are waiting for the visas so we can gain time and avoid delays.
- Project Team will coordinate as much as possible with TRL team before their arrival to Kuwait to finalize parts of the technical specifications as per the RFP to compensate for the delay due to the Visa issues.
- Dima suggested we can start the recruitment of the communication specialist to work on the preparing the awareness campaign in the same time with the recruitment of the project manager.
- Col. Salem expressed that they would prefer to wait till the Project Manager is on board to start working on the Communications plan as the situation at the Ministry is unstable and they want to take things one step at a time with all the proper authorizations required internally at MOI
- Dima suggested Col Salem to speed the process as per the Procurement Plan as we have completed 6 months of the project duration for this year.
