## Narrative

The objective of this project is to assist the Government of the Lao PDR to continue strengthening the National Regulatory Authority (NRA) for the Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) Sector. The NRA is an inter-ministerial body established by a Prime Minister Decree with key roles of coordination, regulation and monitoring to maximise the performance of the UXO sector. Its secretariat, the NRA Office supported by UNDP, provides a UXO focal point in Government administration and has instituted a framework within which implementing organisations work.

The original deliverable outputs of the Project were initially to physically establish the NRA Office as the secretariat, which has been fully achieved, and secondly to support the NRA in execution of its mandate with international assistance. This Annual Work Plan for 2011 will continue building on the foundations established earlier in the Project life.

Crafting a common vision and planning a unified sector approach is an ongoing effort that requires a shared sector strategy, as well as regular exchanges and consultations with all actors of the UXO Sector. The 5 outputs of this 2011 Annual Work Plan are therefore directly driven from the strategic objectives of the National Strategic Plan for the UXO Sector “Safe Path Forward 2” and designed to promote actual implementation of the National Strategic Plan consistent with the Convention on Cluster Munitions (CCM).

UXO contamination and its impact on affected communities seriously impede development, but through NRA coordination and regulation, UXO operators can plan and carry out their activities with greatest effect and aid the realisation of Government plans to improve assistance for the victims and encourage expansion in agriculture, forestry plantations, mining, hydropower generation, and transportation.

Outputs of the project in 2011 will be:

1. Better Mine Risk Education approaches in the Lao PDR.
2. Better information and strategies for victim assistance in the Lao PDR.
3. Release of priority land for agriculture and development coordinated and regulated in accordance with risk reduction and priority needs.
4. Effective coordination and regulation of the UXO Sector, integrated into the regular set-up of the Lao Government.
5. International Treaty Obligations under the Convention on Cluster Munitions are met.






