### Brief Description

The purpose project will enable the Lao Democratic Republic (Lao PDR) to prepare its Second National Communication (SNC) to the Conference of the Parties (COP) of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). The activities of the SNC formulation project are a continuation and an update of the work undertaken by the Lao PDR in preparing its First National Communication during 1997-2000. In addition, gender concerns and perspectives will be taken into account throughout the project cycle. The project has four main outputs: (a) an inventory of greenhouse gases; (b) programs containing measures to facilitate adequate adaptation to, and mitigation of, climate change; (c) programs and plans that are considered relevant for the achievement of the objectives of the UNFCCC and (d) preparation of the SNC of Lao PDR. Besides the preparation of the SNC, the project will further increase the general awareness of climate change issues and build national capacity in the Lao PDR. The project will also facilitate the integration of climate change and gender concerns into the national development policies development policies and plans by strengthening cooperation between all relevant stakeholders.

### Narrative

The main objective of the SNC project is to enable the Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR) to prepare its Second National Communication (SNC) to the Conference of the Parties (CoP) of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

For 2010, the SNC project will focus on: 1) National Circumstances, 2) National Greenhouse Gas Inventory, 3) Draft programs containing measures to facilitate adequate adaptation and mitigation to climate change, 4) Draft programs Containing Measures to Mitigate Climate Change, 5) Project management and 6) Addressing climate change challenges
