Narrative

Project background and objective

The main objective of the project is to strengthen business member organizations (LNCCI, 7 provincial Chamber of Commerce and Industries (CCI) and 5 Business Associations) in order to enable them to provide effective services to the private sector which in turn will contribute to accelerating private sector growth.

The project seeks to support the development of the private sector in Laos, in particular Small and Medium Sized Enterprises (SME), by 1) optimising the use of research findings and recommendations in the areas of private sector development and the business enabling environment; 2) strengthening the capacities of chambers of commerce and industry and business associations so that they can become independent, self-reliant and self-financing organizations providing effective and income generating services to the business community; 3) strengthening the capacities of chambers of commerce and industry and business associations to carry out advocacy on behalf of their members.

Ultimately, the project will contribute to an improved enabling business environment, accelerated growth of private businesses, increased exports, and increase in the number and profitability of SMEs. The project strategy is based on the premise that strong and functional Business Member Organizations (BMO) are essential for the development of a vigorous private business sector. BMOs can support private sector development (i) by providing various kinds of services to their members, or by encouraging others (private business development service providers, training institutes, etc.) to provide such services; and, (ii) by acting as an intermediary between the public sector (central Government, line ministries, provincial governments) and private businesses in a public-private sector dialogue on business sector-related development issues.

Annual key priorities

Based on the key outputs of the project, the key priorities for the year 2008 are:

- 1. Remarket reviews of existing research findings and recommendations study in concise and actionable presentations.
- 2. Strengthen management capacities of selected Chambers of Commerce and Industry and Business Associations.
- 3. Deliver project management and technical services pertaining to previous outputs including audits

Annual key deliverables

In accordance to the key priorities above, the key deliverables for each key priorities of the project are:

- 1. Final report of review of existing Private Sector Development (PSD) studies/reports published. Workshops to dissemination the result of the review of existing PSD studies/reports conducted.
- 2. Capacity of LNCCI to provide management training and online support services to regional CCIs and other BMOs strengthened. IT department of LNCCI is enable to design, develop, implement and administer internal database, local network, printing and file sharing, as well as hardware and software support services to the other departments of LNCCI. A functioning document flow and archive is set up to enable members and BMO to access. Financial procedures, accounting and budget planning modernized. Suitable legal basis for modern chamber and BMO operations and representation established.
- 3. The project is properly monitored with monitoring plan systematically prepared and implemented.
