

### Brief Description

The Poverty-Environment Initiative (PEI) Phase I in Lao PDR was implemented over 2009-2011 with a focus on addressing the impacts of foreign direct investments on poverty and environment. The overall goal of PEI Phase I was to support the effective integration of the environmental concerns of poor and vulnerable groups into policy, planning and implementation processes for poverty reduction, pro-poor growth and achievement of the MDGs. The PEI Phase II programme builds on this body of work and lessons from the initial Phase I, **with the objective to strengthen capacity of targeted central and provincial authorities to integrate poverty-environment concerns in development planning for sustainable and inclusive growth.** This goal is embedded in the overall UN Development Assistance Framework (UNDAF) for 2012-2015. Specifically, the PEI Phase II programme is critically designed to deliver Output 1.4 of UNDAF and contributes towards Outputs 1.3 and 8.3

As in Phase I, PEI Phase II is not a stand-alone project. It is a multi-output programme that is also designed to provide targeted support to ongoing UNDP programmes. **Although the overall PEI programme**

covers five outputs, this framework document outlines the Results and Resources Framework and detailed annual workplans for three outputs: Output 2 to be implemented by the Investment Promotion Department of MPI, Output 3 by Department of Environmental and Social Impact Assessment of MONRE, and Output 5 by the National Economic Research Institute of MPI. Outputs 1 and 4 are implemented through the existing UNDP Support to the MPI and SELNA programmes.

The PEI-ESIA Phase II aims to support the Department of Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (DESIA) of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MONRE) to strengthen the environmental and social impact assessment (ESIA) review and monitoring processes, particularly for agriculture and forestry plantation sector, as a safeguard for sustainable and climate-resilient development.

The timeframe for PEI Phase II Framework Lao PDR is 39 months, from October 2012 to December 2015. PEI will continue to work at the central level, in the original four pilot provinces (Phongsaly, Oudomxay, Savannakhet, Saravan), and extend to two additional provinces, Vientiane and Houaphan.

#### Key priorities

Based on the key outputs of the project, the key priorities for October - December 2012 are:

Support the development and operation of sustainable ESIA funding system through finalizing the "financial management manual" for DESIA as well as assist DESIA with the implementation of the manual, by supporting specific training on financial management and budgeting as needed by different levels within the department.

Support materials and finalize general technical guidelines such as monitoring procedure guidelines (Lao version) as well as EIA report writing guidelines for developers and consultants for the preparation of EIA reports. The finalization of the two guidelines will be conducted through extensive consultation.

**Key deliverables:** In accordance to the key priorities specified above, the key deliverables for each key priority of the project are:

1. Workshop on initial result of DESIA sustainable financing assessment study;
2. Workshop to finalise sustainable financing assessment study;
3. External consultation workshop with concerned line agencies on the updated EIA report writing guidelines Lao-version;
4. 2nd joint monitoring between DESIA (PEI-Output 3) and IPD (PEI-Output 2) on Rubber Tree Plantation Development Project in Champasack province;
5. Internal consultation workshop within DESIA staff to finalise EIA report writing guidelines Lao-version;
6. Short-term training on accountant (Lao CPA) for staff of Financial and Planning Division, DESIA;
7. Short-term training on application of financial management software for staff of Financial and Planning Division, DESIA;
8. PEI Phase II inception workshop.
