ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT

1. Pursuant to the Agreement regarding the UNDP/Sida Trust Fund for Assistance to UNDP concluded between Sweden, through Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency, ("Sida") and the United Nations Development Programme ("UNDP") on the first of September 2000 and the revision of the fourth of May 2007, (the "Trust Fund Agreement"), I am pleased to inform you of the intention of Sida to make available a contribution (the "Contribution") of a maximum of forty million Swedish kronor (SEK 40 000 000) to be administered by UNDP for the:

- A maximum of 19 000 000 SEK - Community Based Recovery and Development in Liberia, Project Number 00059842, Sida Dnr 2009-00319, component 52090002-01
- A maximum of 18 000 000 SEK - County Support Team Project in Liberia Project Number 00052947, Sida Dnr 2009-00319, Component 52090002-02
- A maximum of 3 000 000 - Human Rights Advisor in Liberia, Project Number 00061341, Sida Dnr 2009-000319, Component 52090002-03

The terms of the Trust Fund Agreement shall apply to the Contribution. UNDP shall administer the Contribution in accordance with the provisions of the Trust Fund Agreement, except as otherwise provided herein.

The objectives of the project/programme are:

Community Based recovery and Development Project: Increased access to productive employment and equal opportunities for sustainable livelihoods, especially for vulnerable groups and in consideration of conflict factors.

County Support Project:

- a) Capacity of county officials developed, b) Data/information management in the counties strengthened, and, c) Functionality of administrative buildings restored

7. UNDP shall inform Sida of any significant deviation from agreed plans and budgets. Sida may at any time withhold disbursement if major deviations occur.
8. Sida and UNDP and other engaged donors shall meet every year to plan and review the progress of ongoing activities of the programme/project.
9. This Administration Agreement shall enter into force 1st of March 2009 and remain valid until 30th of September 2011 unless terminated earlier by either of the Parties giving three months' written notice to the other.
10. I would like to propose that this letter shall, upon your confirmation and agreement below, constitute an agreement between Sida and UNDP.
