I am pleased to inform you that we have approved USD 100,000 (One hundred thousand) to support response to the severe floods in the Sidi Ifni region in Morocco. In accordance with the TRAC 1.1.3 guidelines, please note that these funds should be used to support coordination efforts, needs assessments and initiating early recovery frameworks. Funding will be made available from TRAC 1.1.3; (Response to Sudden Crisis Category (II) Window of the TRAC 1.1.3, Atlas fund code: 04120; donor code 00012).

We have established the authorized spending limit (ASL) in Atlas to facilitate immediate response. Please ensure that electronic copies of the signed project document, as well as quarterly progress reports, are uploaded in Atlas.

Kindly note that the project must be completed within 12 months of its approval date. If the project cannot be closed within this period of time, a request for extension, together with a justification, should be submitted at least three months in advance of the expiration date.
