Amendment No. 1 to the UN to UN Agency Contribution Agreement BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMME AND

THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (UNDP)

RELATING TO THE PROJECT Consommation et production durables pour une économie à faible émission de carbone dans le secteur tourisme au Maroc: International Climate Initiative (ICI)

Pursuant to Article H of the UN to UN Agency Contribution Agreement ref: DTIE16-SC029 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") of 30 June 2016 between the United Nations Environment Programme (hereinafter referred to as "UN Environment") and UNDP (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties") with respect to the project "Consommation et production durables pour une économie à faible émission de carbone dans le secteur tourisme au Maroc: International Climate Initiative (ICI)", the Parties agree to amend the Agreement.

The purpose of this Amendment No. 1 is to reflect an extension of the duration of the Agreement up to 30 November 2018 and to provide additional funding of USD 180,000, amounting to a total of USD 330,000. The Amendment No.1 is required to reflect additional activities to be

undertaken under the agreement, in line with agreements with the donor as per the global project document of the 'Advance SCP' project, which is providing the funds for the activities. The additional activities concern the development of a NAMA for the tourism sector in Morocco, a carbon footprint at the Marrakesh city level, and support to an International Conference on Sustainable Tourism and related associated coordination costs. Details of the activities are outlined in Annex I (project document).

- 1.4 Section E. Contributions is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

E. CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amounts paid by the Contributing Agency shall match the total budget amount. For Activities less than one year in duration the Contribution will be paid to the Recipient Agency prior to the commencement of Activities. For multi-year Activities the Contribution will be paid in instalments according to the following schedule.

The Contributing Agency acknowledges that the Recipient Agency will not pre-finance Activities. If the Contribution, or any part of it, is not received in a timely manner, the Activities may be reduced or suspended by the Recipient Agency with immediate effect.
