NARRATIVE

Approval of funding from the Expanded "Delivering As One" (DAO) Funding Window comes at a critical time for the Maldives. It is a country struggling with a protracted transition process as it attempts to cement a nascent democracy. Under this transition and under a worrying fiscal position, it is trying to work towards achieving the national development priorities outlined in the Strategic Action Plan. It has already achieved 5 out of the 8 Millennium Development Goals, but is at great risk of sliding backwards if no deliberate efforts are made to sustain the gains and address the challenges to MDGs achievement. At a time when additional donor support has been needed, the Maldives' graduation is expected to result in likely cuts in funding. Weaknesses in aid coordination institutions and systems and the lack of a strategic international cooperation strategy will not help improve the country's already bleak fiscal picture.

The UN has been has been moving closer to Delivering as One practice, and it is appreciative of the recognition it has received from the Steering Committee of the DAO Funds. Utilizing the Funds, the UN team, jointly with the Government of the Maldives, will be addressing strategic priorities for the year where which are high impact, transformational, and value for money. Using the One UN approach, the projects will support the rolling-out of the Managing for Development Results approach, accelerated actions toward achieving the MDGs by the global deadline, and enhanced aid effectiveness.
