The purpose of the Amendment is to reflect changes in the Project Document related to:

1. Resource allocation – reflection of new contribution received for project activities
2. Project results and resources framework regarding above
3. Annual Workplan regarding above.

**1. Resource allocation**

The allocated resources are increased in the total amount of 110,000 EUR from the following sources of funding:

- 50,000 EUR from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Montenegro,
- 60,000 EUR from the programme part of the Government’s Local Office Contribution (GLOC).

**Resources to be mobilized**

The resources in the estimated amount of 50,000 EUR will be mobilized from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Montenegro in 2023.

**Revision of activities related to Result 2**

Following result will be revised with this Amendment to the Project Document:

**Summer School for Young Diplomats:** Diplomatic Academy will lead the implementation of four subsequent editions of the summer school for young diplomats.

Special attention will be given to the issues related to the role and significance of diplomacy in maintaining the international peace and security, overcoming crises, and developing new models of economic, political and security cooperation in international arena. It will also provide an opportunity for young diplomats to get acquainted with the history, culture, as well as foreign policy priorities of the participating countries, and establish through learning, exchange of views and socializing, mutual rapport, and the basis for future cooperation.

The Summer School will bring together a considerable number of participants from the countries of the region, the European Union and from all over the world, as well as prominent

lecturers who will bring closer contemporary issues of international politics to their younger colleagues. It is expected to have 50 participants from at least 30 countries of the globe yearly.
