This has been highlighted by continued post-conflict peace and security, political stability and macro-economic management that have been conducive to growth and development. Political and economic reforms in the country are allowing for an ever-increasing role for the sub-national levels in policy development and implementation. This process, however, needs to be accompanied by an increased access to information which can disseminate information about the development status of the provinces, districts and municipalities. This would contribute substantially to the strengthening of planning, monitoring and evaluation systems and processes using both quantitative and qualitative information. The programme will focus on strategic capacity-building aspects that will improve the capacity of TVM.
