Concept Note for TRAC 2 funded UNDP Mauritius Innovation Project

Introduction

The United Nations in Mauritius initiated the establishment of a Technology Innovation Labs (UNTIL) to drive the development agenda, through Innovation and technology, and to solve some of humanities' most pressing needs.

The objectives of these labs were to function as a start-up platform for a collaborative attempt to problem solving initiatives among the UN entities, Private sector, Academia and Civil Society. This would serve as the platform for linking with innovators and mentors from across the globe as well as to facilitate global exchange of ideas and resources, offering advisory support and guidance that will facilitate solutions through workshops, immersion-learning, and incubated projects.

On October 12, the Government of Mauritius, through its Council of Ministers endorsement, agreed to set up the UNTIL in the island. A two-days' workshop was organized by UNDP in Mauritius on 22 and 23 November 2018 to discuss the proposals with the stakeholders.

Following which, UNDP Mauritius submitted a proposal for additional resources to fund the preparatory work for this innovative solution in accelerating the development agenda and to establish initial activities to support the Government of Mauritius' vision for the Innovation labs. The proposal envisaged to create enabling environment for innovation in Mauritius, to bring different actors to discuss and exchange views and ideas and to engage in upstream policy dialogue for Innovation.

The proposed thematic areas would be the following:

- 1. SDG 1 No Poverty
- 2. SDG 5 Gender Equality
- 3. SDG 9 Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure
- 4. SDG 10 Reduced Inequalities

UNDP Mauritius submitted the request for funding from TRAC 2 Resources for this project in November 2018. The total amount requested was USD 350,000 but the approved amount for this initiative was USD 136,452 for 2019 which resulted in scaling down the original planned activity to one major output.



Proposed use of Resources

As the UNTIL project has not been moving at the level of MOFA, the stakeholders have not been engaging although reminders were sent to them regarding UNTIL project.

Given that UNDP Mauritius has been approached to be part of the Estonia- UNDP Cooperation on Digital Transformation as Sustainable Development Pathway on 20th February 2019, Mauritius has been invited to be the very first country for pilot by HQ/BPPS. This will bring lot of visibility and scope for resource mobilization.

The resources allocated will be utilized to create a new Innovation project for UNDP Mauritius and shall deliver the following output:

Output 1 - Support the Government of Mauritius in engaging in innovation initiatives in Mauritius

The Activities will be:

- 1.1 Conduct a scoping mission to assess the digital landscape;
- Draft a project document and mobilize funds at national, regional and international level 1.2
- 1.3 Deploy technical experts for innovation Initiatives
- 1.4 Present the findings at the UNGA 2019
- 1.5 Publish and communicate innovation initiatives in Mauritius

RISK ASSESSMENT

Procurement risk - delay in hiring of consultants/experts may result in corresponding Risk 1delays of programme delivery

Risk 2 -Organizational risk - lack of support staff may have an impact on the timely disbursement of allocated funds as the unit has only one National Officer who may be unable to closely follow up on the projects' activities and timeliness.



Risk 3 - Political risk and lack of political will - General Elections are foreseen in early 2020. So the Government offices functioning may slow down in the run up to elections towards the second half of 2019. Due to the uncertainties for future, the line ministry especially the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and other stakeholders would no longer be interested in pursuing this project.
