#### **Brief Description**

The project is designed to support existing structures, specifically the Public Affairs Committee (PAC), in providing platforms for collaborative dialogue, peace building and conflict prevention. This is in line with the constitutional provision, section 13(l), which calls for the “adoption of mechanisms for peaceful settlement of conflicts through, among other strategies; conciliation, and mediation to ensure that the country is secure and democratically mature”. Following the implementation of the 2014 AWP which resulted amongst others in the signing of the Lilongwe Peace Declaration by all 12 Presidential candidates of the May 2014 elections, and the establishment of a 15-member high level mediation panel credited for contributing immensely to peaceful elections, UNDP will continue to support PAC in the roles of Advocacy, Dialogue and facilitating collaborative leadership. Particular focus for 2015 will be on strengthening national level mediation and dialogue facilitation capacities, and also the development of a shared minimum national agenda. The project will continue to facilitate the initiated national debate on Inclusivity and Federalism, taking the debate to the regional levels in order to obtain national consensus on the matter. The AWP will also continue to support the pilot conflict early warning and early

reporting structures at the district level, in order to make them more effective in their role in conflict prevention.
