June 2019	Operation (human resources) and Capacity	Output 2 put forward a proposed Gender Mainstreaming Framework to MWFCD. The Framework contained recommendations on both legislative framework and administrative framework. The structure is broad and extended beyond MWFCD's mandate and authority.
		At Ministry level, many internal discussions were organized to clarify and identify practical next steps to kick-start institutionalizing gender mainstreaming. The Ministry has agreed to form a Gender Focal Team (GFT) as a start, to support the Gender Focal Point (GFP). The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the GFP and GFT was developed and there are other planned activities for GFT in the pipeline for 2019 within MWFCD. The Plan is to roll-out to a few other Ministries starting 2020.
		In the meantime, Output 4 will focus on strengthening internal capacity of MWFCD's GFT to implement the proposed Gender Mainstreaming Framework activities.
