#### Issues & Challenges:

After the 13th General Election on 9<sup>th</sup> May, it was required for the B40 recommendations to also consider and align with initiatives stipulated in the Buku Harapan (Pakatan Harapan's manifesto).

In line with the people-centric initiatives as stipulated in Buku Harapan, EPU is also interested to implement a community pilot project at the local level based on the recommendation of the consultant, as a proof of concept.

Overall, these changes have contributed to the delay of the finalization of the consultant's report.

#### Action Taken by implementing Partner:

EPU and UNDP has both provided inputs for the conceptualization of the pilot project based on the recommendation from the consultant.

It was agreed that the project budget balance could be utilized to implement the proposed pilot project, upon approval from PSC (to be arranged in 4Q of 2018).
