### SECTION 2: 2018 Project Progress/Contribution to National Development Agenda

1.1 Please elaborate project's contribution to the review/revision/formulation of national or sectoral policies, strategies and action plans, in line with the mid-term review of the 11<sup>th</sup> Malaysia Plan and relevant sectoral policies.

The GHG emissions projection until 2015 which has been developed under the project provides guidance on how Malaysia's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) can be achieved. Quantified information on 17 mitigation action programmes taken by the country has also been developed, which is used as basis for implementing and tracking the country's GHG emissions reductions. A review of national policies, master plans, action plans and programmes which have implications to climate change mitigation was included in the Third National Communications Report.

The project also helped to prepare a detailed assessment of the country's vulnerability and adaptation options for climate change, where assessments have been carried out for water and coastal resources, infrastructure, agriculture and food security, forestry and biodiversity sectors, to name a few. A review of the adequacy of current adaptation measures have also been carried out. These assessments will assist Malaysia in the formulation of a comprehensive National National Adaptation Plan.

- 1.3 What has the project done in 2018 to build/strengthen capacity to implement or sustain systemic changes? (Institutional Capacity Development)





Malaysia uses Technical Working Groups (TWGs) and Sub Working Groups (SWGs) as the primary approach towards climate change reporting, supplemented by consultants where expertise and manpower is lacking. Most of the members of these TWGs and SWGs are from government agencies and academia. For areas where expertise is still insufficient at the TWGs and SWGs, local consultants are employed to help in the work. This approach has enabled capacities to be developed and retained at the government agencies during the course of the project. For the GHG inventory, more than 30 inventory compilers have been trained and most of these experts are at the institutes that coordinate the SWGs. For mitigation assessment, local consultants have been employed to supplement the expertise required. Project activities such as the implementation of studies, assessments and participation in workshops have enabled institutional capacities to be built within government agencies.

These data are being used by the Implementing Partner for the purpose of formulating national and sectoral policies on climate change mitigation.

Apart from the statistics on population, gender statistics related to climate change issues have not been collected in Malaysia. However the project does not discriminate gender in the implementation and provides equal opportunity to all gender at all levels of work.
