

## Amendment No. 1 to the UN Agency to UN Agency Contribution Agreement

The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) and

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)

The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (hereinafter referred to as "UNODC") and the United Nations Development Programme (hereinafter referred to as "UNDP") have agreed to amend the UN Agency to UN Agency Contribution Agreement concluded between them in April 2013 on support to the implementation of Outcome 3 of the project NGAX60 - Support to Anti-Corruption in Nigeria in line with UN standards and norms (hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement") as follows:

- 1. The duration of the Agreement in Section A (Summary of Activities) will be extended until 31 December 2014.
- 2. The period during which all expenditure must be incurred in Section D (Reporting Financial Reporting) is amended to read:

All expenditure must be incurred between the effective date of this Agreement and 31 December 2014.

- 3. The Amendment is effective upon signature of the Parties.
- 4. The Agreement shall in all other respects remain unchanged.
