Consultancy for Conducting on Enhancing Advocacy and Leadership of Women Leaders from Bara and Parsa districts

Completion report

The objectives of the consultancy assignment was to prepare and deliver a two and half days training sessions to women leaders from Bara and Parsa districts. This consultancy report is produced upon successfully completion of the consultancy. The report contains the consultant's observation and some recommendations for future.

Facilitation of a two and half days training sessions

I prepared training materials based on the training manual and facilitated the training between 8-10 February 2016 in Hotel Orchid, in Hetauda.

Observation and learning

The training participants who came from Bara and Parsa districts were women leaders working in Inter-Party Women's Alliance (IPWA), rights and empowerment, Dalits issues and non-government sectors. With few exceptions, all the participants had almost similar level of experience, which brought a rich experience to the discussions in the training.

The participants' feedback on the training was highly positive. The participants especially appreciated the facilitation methods, which included workshops, games with a message related to the curriculum and audio-video inputs. The participants liked the session on 14 steps of local development planning and the session on localising GRB. According to the participants, even though they were working on local development issues, their knowledge on these two topics was limited. The participants also mentioned that they have important learning on advocacy including the ideas about different steps of advocacy. They appreciated the use of short documentaries, cartoons and songs as a facilitation tool used in the training.

Following lessons are learned and recommendations provided based on the participants feedback.

 Leadership and advocacy could be an important area of capacity building for the members of IPWA as well as social/NGO leaders. However, the participants suggested that such training should reach out to more women leaders at VDC level. Thus a recommendation in this regard is to provide ToT to women leaders from this group and engage them in providing trainings at local levels.

- GRB is a new concept; many participants were not familiar at all to it's mechanisms, strategies and frameworks. This training could only sensitised participants on this issue. It is recommended to organise a follow up training (more simplified as per the level of the participants) on GRB at both district and local level.
- At the end of the training, the participants have developed a Work Plan on Leadership and Advocacy with respect to promoting social cohesion and increasing women's involvement in local development processes. It is recommended to organise follow ups to assess to what extent the participants have worked together to implement the work plan.

Final remarks

The assignment is completed within the agreed deadline.
