5. Key Discussions Points:

- a) First meeting of the Programme Management Committee (PMC) under the Building Disaster Resilience in Pakistan (BDRP) programme was held on March 26th, 2019 at 10:00 hrs in the office of Director General Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Civil Secretariat Peshawar. The honourable DG PDMA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mr Parvaiz Khan chaired the meeting. Recitation of Holly Quran followed by a formal welcome of the meeting participants and acknowledgement of their participation.
- b) A joint presentation was given by FAO and Concern representatives. The presentation highlighted key achievements of the BDRP Phase-I. The forum was informed that the programme benefitted a considerable number of individuals including male, female, persons with disability and elderly community members through CBDRM, WASH, infrastructure and livelihood interventions. They were also informed about strategic and policy level support extended at national and provincial level in Phase-I.
- c) The presentation also covered core components of BDRP programme implementation phase-II in KP, which will be implemented by Sep 2020. The key activities are expected to deliver positive results both at provincial level and on the target communities of both selected districts (D.I. Khan and Chitral). A detail work plan for the upcoming quarter covering both components CBDRM and Institutional strengthening was also part of the presentation. At the end of presentation, a way forward for the BDRP-II Programme in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was also shared that includes Notification of selected union councils of Phase II by PDMA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and also requested district administration representatives to notify district technical support groups (TSG).
- d) The forum was informed that the BDRP phase -II programme will be implemented in the 2 targeted districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with total of 14 Union Councils, which include UCs Ayun, Lotkoh, Shoghore, Karimabad, Yarkhoon, Kosht and Owir of Chitral and UCs Chahkan, Mandhra, Gandi Umer Khan, Khap Shumali, Kat Garh, Bilot Sharif and Lar of D.I. Khan. In response to the question regarding criteria for selection of UCs in Khyber

Pakhtunkhwa, the representative of FAO and Concern responded that these UCs were selected on the basis of their prevailing risks and vulnerabilities following multi-hazard criteria. A comprehensive assessment was also carried out in collaboration with key stakeholders at district, UCs and village levels. The list of selected UCs were further shared in the provincial inception workshops for further review and finalisation.

Following are some recommendations made by DG PDMA and other stakeholders, which are well noted for future reference and further action:

- a. DRM Specialist PDMA KP informed the forum that all activities related to MHVRA and institutional support for District DRR should be carried out in consultation with the PDMA office. He further added that the consortium should share list of volunteers / communal groups trained under the CBDRM component with the PMDA.
- b. On presenting the next quarter plan, DG PDMA recommended to make future presentations with necessary details like district wise budget, targets, key steps towards achieving those targets and timeline so that quarterly progress against each target / activity should be traceable and measured in the next PMC meetings.
- c. In response to the development of provincial working group on Public Private Partnership (PPP) under the BDRP project, the DG PDMA noted that in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, presently there is no such partnership exist among public and private sector on disaster risk reduction. He emphasized on the need to identify potential private sector institutions who can work with PDMA in building resilience in disaster affected / prone areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. He further added that at initial stages some model interventions can be initiated and can be further upscaled. The UNDP responded that there are good examples of public and private sector partnerships in other provinces and the best practices can be adapted in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- d. On the notification of selected UCs from PDMA, Deputy Director (O&C) PMDA Mr. Ilyas Khan informed the forum that each implementing partner operating in KP should obtain NOC first for the project implementation from PDMA. He further advised to collect a detailed checklist from his office and apply for the NOC by filling those checklists. Concern and ACTED are to follow the process. DG PDMA advised his staff to support the partners in processing the NOC in the coming days, meanwhile also advised Consortium members to carry on the activities in the districts without any break.
- e) Mr. Akhlaq Ahmad from DFID extend acknowledgment to PMC members for their participation and support. He further added that next PMC meeting will provide an opportunity to discuss issues, challenges and opportunities. Ms. Ayesha, DFID representative reiterated to strengthen coordination at district level among BDRP Consortium members and district authorities.
