

(II) Summary of the project

Housing problems have been identified as the number one reason for leaving Jerusalem by Palestinian families. UNDP/PAPP is entrusted by the Government of Italy a Grant of US\$ 1.5 million for the implementation of the project to improve the physical and social infrastructure services in the selected areas of the Jerusalem area. The Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem has been selected for this project as one of the impact areas and the activities will consist of Landscaping, Construction and Finishing Works.



(V) Narrative Report:

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 02 February 2011 between the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem, represented by Mons. William Shomali and the UNDP/PAPP Special Representative of the Administrator, Mr. Timothy Rothermel, as the executing/implementing Agency. (Annex 1)

A Third-Party Cost Sharing Agreement was also signed between the Italian Consulate in Jerusalem, representing the "Donor" and UNDP/PAPP, on 25 March 2011 for a total grant value of Euros 1,060,970.00. (Annex 2)







Following the signing of the agreement, and based on the above mentioned, and duly-signed MoU, UNDP/PAPP approved the design, technical drawing and the technical Bill of Quantities presented by the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem's technical consultants Messrs. "Simon Kouba Architects Town Planner". (Annex 6)

On 07 July 2011 UNDP/PAPP signed a contract for the 'Supply and installation of 9 elevators for the Sharafat Social Housing Project in Beit Safafa' with the International Elevators Group for an amount of USD 302,666.67. On 14 July 2011 UNDP/PAPP proceeded with the handover of the project site to M/S International Elevators Group and on 01 August 2011 the contractor – in line with the proposed and approved workplan – started the civil works. During the first three months, civil works were completed and the contractor started the installation of the elevators (door frames and guide rails) in five of the selected buildings. To date, the contractor was not able to implement all the activities in his work plan, as the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem has not been able to live up to its commitment for accomplishing the requested tasks, in order for UNDP/PAPP to implement the elevators' activities on time. (Annex 3 and 3/A)

In particular, the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem – in comparison with the approved and signed work plan - did not deliver on time the following items:

- 1. Temporary electrical 3 phase line for each building;
- 2. Storage area in each building;
- 3. Final tiling levels in the phase 2 (3 buildings). (Annex 4)

Based on the above, on 06 October 2011, the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem requested UNDP/PAPP to postpone the installation of the 9 elevators for a period of three months. (Annex 5) UNDP/PAPP immediately informed the contractor and requested that he submits modified work plan and to amend the contract either temporarily (3 months delay) or financially (rent of external storage area for three months).

Meanwhile, UNDP/PAPP launched the tender for the external civil works and landscaping. On 20 October 2011, UNDP/PAPP signed a contract for the 'Civil Works at the Sharafat Social Housing Project in Beit Safafa' with M/S Abu Kteish Brothers Company for a maximum amount of USD 747,816.00. The expected date for the project site handover is 14 November 2011.

(VII) Challenges

The Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem still needs to work on fulfilling its obligations for the Project by finalizing the agreement with the Jerusalem District Electricity Company- JDECO - to provide a temporary 3-phase electrical line on site and to improve the status of the works in the phases no. 1 and 2 (5+3 buildings) to allow UNDP/PAPP's contractors to install the elevators and to start the civil works (boundary walls, landscaping, etc.).









(VIII) Planned Ongoing Works:










Phase n.2 - Building n. 1 - Staircase and elevator's shaft (Up to now no tiling level has been defined)




Phase n.3 – Building n. 1 – Scaffolding in the elevators shafts









Phase n.1 – Western side – Location of the western boundary wall and internal road




Phase n.1 – Northern side - Location of the northern boundary wall and internal road











Phase n.2 – Northern side - Location of the northern boundary wall and internal road
