Subject: Funding for 7th Philippine Human Development Report (PHDR)

The Philippines Human Development Network (HDN) has submitted a proposal to fund the preparation of the 7th Philippine Human Development Report (PHDR) with theme on "Space, Place and Human Development".

The GOP-UNDP-HDN partnership has published six PHDRs with themes on human development (1994), gender (1997), basic education (2000), work and well-being (2003), human security (2005) and institutions and politics (2008/09), that have influenced the policy discourse on human development in the country. The HDN also published recently the book "In Search of a Human Face: 15 Years of Knowledge Building for Human Development in the Philippines", which provides an update on previous themes of the PHDR.

The HDN was set up in 1992 through the efforts of NEDA and UNDP to sustainably pursue human development outcomes in the Philippines through the preparation of a national HDR and the advocacy of human development. This initiative came after UNDP adopted the human development concept in 1990 and applied it to a systematic study of global themes, as published in the yearly global HDRs and later in regional and national HDRs.

The 7th PHDR will explore the geographic aspects of human development in the Philippines and will probe into both environmental and economic geography but in a more basic, context-specific way. It will look into geography and how it may help explain both sub-national and community-based living conditions and trends and the spatial impact of specific public policies and programs thus far. It will also seek to generate concrete findings and a greater understanding of how human development outcomes in the Philippines across time and space have been directly or indirectly influenced by physical and environmental processes, features and phenomena, and vice versa.
