Pre-Pac noted that questions 9,11,14,15, 20, 21, 25 and 26 had options of either yes or no. All these were rated Yes.	Pre- Pac advised focal point to have evidence available in narrative description as this is needed when uploading Quality Assurance online.
Pre-Pac noted recommended that ratings for questions 1,2,7,8,10,12,16 &17 were increased from 2 -3.

- Pre Pac advised that LPAC was held on August 10, with meeting chaired by Sharon Sakuma (UN Coordination Specialist). An electronic Pre –Pac organised earlier but as proper process not followed this was rescheduled to August 18.
- Kevin Petrini noted lesson learnt - to avoid formulating complicated
