Brief Summary of Mission Outputs/Findings:

The purpose of this meeting is to bring together all partners (Government, Private Sector and NGOs) to meet bi-monthly and discuss Disaster Risk Management issues in the region. This is an avenue where the Regional Disaster Office can take stock of agencies dealing with DRM in the region and better coordinate in its efforts to building resilient communities in the region. The first meeting conducted in April had a very good turnout. The second meeting had new agencies in board.

Apart from the Humanitarian Partners Coordination Meeting, the UNDP together with IOM and AROB Disaster Office had an opportunity to present to the Bougainville Parliamentarians about the work around Disaster Risk Management that is currently supported by the United Nations.
