I. PURPOSE

The objective of this Programme Preparation Consultancy is to develop the project concepts into the full scale project documents under the Socio-Economic Development component of CPAP (2011-2015).

The programme will be designed for promoting sustainable livelihoods and enhanced socio-economic services for the rural population in close collaboration with the Government.

It includes revitalizing production activities of county and village (ri) -based small and medium-sized (S&M) food-processing and daily-necessities factories (FDFs) and local home cooperatives (LHCs) in rural areas, in order to widen opportunities for employment and income generation thereof.

The Programme Implementation will be through execution by United Nations Industrial Development Organizations, in line with EB Decision DP/2009/8.

II. EXPECTED OUTPUT

The main focus of this preparatory work is on producing a series of documents drawing on the programme and project ideas under the Socio-Economic Development Component of CPAP.

The expected project documents are;

- Capacity Building and Production/Revitalization of Select Local Food-Processing Factories
- Wild Fruit and Edible Plant Processing for Nutrition Improvement and Food Security in the Mountainous Areas of DPRK
- Capacity Building of Local Raw Material Bases For Soap And Paper Production
- Production Revitalization of Daily-Necessities Factories Based on Their Own Raw Material Bases
- Capacity Building of Local Home Cooperatives for More Productive Activities and Improved Income Generation

All the project concepts have already been drafted by the Ministry of Food and Daily-necessities Industry in cooperation with the State Commission for Science and Technology, and the UNDP DPRK sent them to a UNIDO consultant for reference.

III. MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENTS

A UNIDO staff will be invited to visit DPRK CO to work on formulation of projects working under the guidance of the Senior Deputy Resident Representative of the Country Office and will work in close collaboration with National Coordination Committee, the main official UNDP counterpart, the Ministry of Food and Daily-necessities Industry and the State Commission for Science and Technology.

Fellow-up visits by UNIDO might be needed as well as possible hiring additional consultants.

The field visits of proposed project sites will be arranged by the CO. The project will be cleared by UNDP Headquarters.
