

TRANSFER OF TITLE OF ASSETS FROM THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME TO THE RYUDONG COOPERATIVE FARM, UNSAN COUNTY, SOUTH PYONGAN PROVINCE, DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA

THIS AGREEMENT made on 22 September 2015, by and between the United Nations Development Programme (hereinafter referred to as "UNDP"), for the transfer to the Ryudong Cooperative Farm, Unsan County, South Pyongan Province, Democratic People's Republic of Korea (hereinafter referred to as the "Beneficiary"), accepts full title and ownership of assets as specified in the attached supplies and equipment list at a total cost of US\$ 94,399.13.

This first batch of assets disposed/transferred represent assistance of UNDP to the Beneficiary to facilitate Sustainable Rural Energy Development (SRED) Programme, Atlas Award ID 00043495/Project ID 00050817, (hereinafter referred to as "Project"), undertaken in Democratic People's Republic of Korea. 5. Summary of Case:

The TPR Meeting held on 21 October 2014 made a decision to (i) operationally close the Sustainable Rural Energy Development Project (SRED) with no further substantive activity by 31 October 2014 and (ii) continue onsite monitoring/verification of assets until transfer/disposal.

The UNDP CO, however, was informed on 29 January 2015 by Bangkok Regional Hub and OFRM of UNDP that "Project should not be closed in Atlas until assets are disposed of. Thus, the UNDP CO/RR decided on 30 January 2015 to re-open the project to continue onsite verification/monitoring of the assets.

Following intensive consultations with relevant HQ offices (RBAP, PSO, OFRA) to ensure full compliance with the sanction regime imposed on DPR Korea, the BRH commissioned an independent consultant to review all assets procured under the SRED project against the UN sanctions applicable to DPR Korea. The conclusions of the consultant as written in the Final Report – Review of inventories of Operationally Inactive Projects against sanctions regions that relate to DPRK dated 30 March 2015 (Annex 1) were endorsed by the BRH management of which the Country Office was informed accordingly. Thus, as per the instructions of the COSQA/BRH, the CO is pursuing the transfer of non-contentious asset (biogas system – pig farm and household, solar water pumping system, small hydro power, solar P.V system and system for power performance measurement and system for wind resource assessment) to benefit the final end-users at local level.

The Country Office is withholding the transfer of the solar hot water system with water storage tank, the transfer of which still needs to be authorized by the Regional Hub in Bangkok and PSO.

Relevant e-mail exchanges are attached to RAD. All transfers will be done in accordance with the regulations of POPP concerning with the transfer of the UNDP asset and Standard Operating Procedures for UNDP DPRK approved by HQ.
