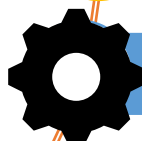

### ➤ *Challenges*

The security situation in the Sahel regions is one of the most pressing challenges for the fulfilment of the project due to difficulties to access remote areas of the country.

At the political level, whenever elections are taking place, it impacts the project's implementation due to the unavailability of local administrations and government partnerships.
