The project has two main components: (i) build national institutional capacity to carry out ODA programs/projects in partner countries (as defined by the National ODA Strategy); (ii) raise awareness at national level on Romanian ODA – this will include an (post-higher) education component focusing on MDG, HD and ODA.

A third component consists of contributing earmarked amounts (in total 1,400,000 Euro) to UNDP COs in The Republic of Moldova, Georgia, Serbia/Kosovo, as well as allocations for Quick Impact Initiatives (QII, in amount of 100,000 Euro). The contributions for Moldova, Georgia, Serbia and Kosovo, will be governed by separate Cost Sharing Agreements to be signed by the Ministry and the Respective UNDP Country Offices. The Secretariat for the QII Trust Fund will be wet-up under the current project, whereas the Trust Fund per se will be set up and run under a regional project.



A third component consists of contributing earmarked amounts (in total 1,300,000 Euro) to UNDP COs in The Republic of Moldova, Georgia, Serbia, as well as allocations for Quick Impact Initiatives (QII, in amount of 200,000 Euro). The contributions for Moldova, Georgia and Serbia are governed by separate Cost Sharing Agreements to be signed by the Ministry and the Respective UNDP Country Offices.
