1. Brief Description of Initiation Plan

The initiation plan will cover initial activities to prepare a project document for Rwanda. The Rwandan component will bring on board the participation of key UN agencies and other developing partners as well. The other UNDP programmes such as Governance to support in the gender aspects as well as Disaster Management will take active roles in the formulation process.
