## Extension of Community Security and Stabilization (C2SP) Programme

Community Security and Stabilization Programme (C2SP) has been operating since 2015 till June 2022 with objectives of enhancing community resilience and stability through livelihood support, socioeconomic infrastructure to boost local economy, and capacity development of community and at-risk population.

While C2SP has successfully supported 75 communities in achieving the above-mentioned objectives, given the current context of Sudan in transition where the Juba Peace Agreement is yet to be implemented, local conflicts and social destabilization over communal issues are frequently reported, and the ongoing economic crises coupled with the political impasse prevailing, Sudan still requires an unwavering support like C2SP more than ever.

Against this background, the C2SP Project Executive Board would propose and hereby endorse the extension of the programme till the 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2024 in order to continue to address needs and threats at the community level within the project framework.
