I am pleased to inform you that the BCPR Project Appraisal Committee (BPAC) has approved the allocation of a total amount of USD500,000 (five hundred thousand) to support the project "UN Support to Sierra Leone Constitutional Process". Funding will be made available from the Conflict Prevention Window of the Thematic Trust Fund for Crisis Prevention and Recovery (Atlas fund code: 26921; donor code: 00012).

In accordance with our resource management guidelines, you are kindly requested to submit a signed final project document, including the detailed Annual Work Plan (AWP), within the next 90 (ninety) days.
