Overall review of programme submission Recommendations

UNDP has been committed to supporting the government of Sierra Leone in its strategy of getting to Zero and staying at Zero. The active response to Ebola has now reached a critical stage where cases are being traced using a crossed functional approached. That means the District Ebola Response Centers and NGOs were still in need of rapidly accessible and flexible funding support that can allow them to respond immediately in carrying out last mile activities. Towards this end, a request was made for an additional \$500,000 to continue fulfilling approved applications made by the DERC and NGOs actively involved in getting to a resilient zero. To this end, we fully endorsed the relocation of these remaining funds to be transferred to UNDP via MPTF. The UNDP proposed activity support to during the no-cost extension will include monitoring and verification of proposed project activities and the evaluation and closure of the QIPs in the selected districts
