NISA SECURITY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT
IN WADAJIR AND WAABERI DISTRICTS, MOGADISHU

1. The President of the Federal Republic of Somalia and the Special Representative of the Secretary General/Designated Official for Security have agreed to the need for improved community based security in Wadajir and Waaberi Districts. In separate meetings, the Director General (DG) of National Intelligence and Security Agency (NISA) was designated as the person with lead responsibility for security coordination on the side of the Somali Federal Government (SFG) and the Chief Security Advisor (CSA) of United Nations Department of Safety and Security (UNDSS), on the side of UN. During separate meetings between the NISA DG and UNDSS CSA the parameters of the community security enhancement project in Wadajir and Waaberi Districts were laid out.

2. Key Points:
 - i. The layout of this project will contribute significantly the future organization and interaction between the SFG's security sector, the local populace and the international community.
 - ii. NISA's stated mandate is to, "identify and block the threats to the state and its citizens, and to reinforce the country's security and safety according to the teachings of Islam and the constitution."
 - iii. NISA will continue to pay the salaries of its personnel. All of the stakeholders understand that funds allocated to NISA personnel in the project are stipends.
 - iv. It is expected that eventually this unit will expand and become Diplomatic Protection Unit.
 - v. The NISA personnel on this project are civilians and have no links to the Ministries of Defense or Interior.
 - vi. Operationally, the personnel on this project fall under the authority of the NISA airport unit, with strong coordination links through UNDSS.
