Project Background

This Project aims to strengthen local resilience and community cohesion affected by the crisis caused by migration through improved service delivery on the local level trough improving planning or service delivery on the local level, improvement of the infrastructural potential to deliver better services to both local population and transiting migrants.

Expected Activities/Results in 2018

The Project is linking immediate response and long-term development objectives of a stable and sustainable community, and approaches combining the humanitarian and development focus. The project is in its final stage, the majority of construction works have been completed. In January 2018, it is expected to complete assessment for improving waste management of the City of Vranje and procure and deliver waste management equipment in February -March 2018. In the period late February, beginning of March, opening events of completed construction projects in Tutin, Sombor and Sid will be organized. In February/March 2018 final evaluation of project will be conducted.
