I. PURPOSE AND EXPECTED OUTPUTS

One of the most significant The biggest conceptual advancements in the Public Service and Human Resource Management In Serbian public administration in 2018 was the establishment of the National Academy for Public Administration (NAPA) as a response to the absence of a well-rounded approach to the issue of the professional development of civil servants within the broader field of Human Resource Management in the public sector and the lack of a clear link and relationship between the general and specific professional development and training programs, and the strategies and objectives of Public Administration Reform (PAR).

This Initiation plan aims to ensures continuous support to the National Academy for Public Administration (NAPA) in capacity building at individual and institution level as well as to increasing the technical capacities of its staffs. The analysis to be conducted during the initiation phase will provide a basis for a more efficient and focused deployment of donor funds through the project that is being developed in response to the priorities of the NAPA.

One of the key outputs of the initiation plan is the development of a project document for a comprehensive project aiming to build on the previous achievements recognized in EU Progress Report and SIGMA Monitoring Report for 20019 and provide effective support to the National Academy for Public Administration in the following areas as follows:

- 1) further building and strengthening of its internal capacity at staff/trainer and institution level
- 2) designing new, innovative and competitive training programs and redesigning of the existing ones in line with the needs of the public sector and the latest global trends of public administration for aligning with the 4th industrial revolution,
- introducing modern e-learning platforms using effective electronic multimedia educational technologies and
- supporting NAPA's international cooperation activities, educational research, as well as outreach activities in order to promote and ensure greater visibility of NAPA's mission and activities.
