I am pleased to inform you that the BCPR Project Appraisal Committee (BPAC) has approved the allocation of a total amount of USD500,000 (five hundred thousand) to support the project "Mainstreaming Climate Change Adaptation and Disaster Risk Reduction in Development Planning in Thailand".
