**Brief Description**

The main scope of the project is to promote the Human Development concept at all levels including the decision-making level, where it will be acknowledged and recognized as a basis and the main criteria in the social dialogue and in the formulation of the national socio-economic policies in Tajikistan. This will be achieved, *inter alia*, through mainstreaming human paradigm through improved understanding of its meaning and practical implications and improving the capacity to formulate and implement policies consistent with human development principles. Important components of the project contributing to its main outcome will be production of National Human Development Reports (NHDRs), human development trainings, support for improving the quality of statistics and capacity to understand statistics and use in day-to-day policy making as well as support to establish and further develop an independent national research institution which will respond to the urgent needs of assisting with policy advice in key socio-economic areas. The project output is to mainstream human development in policy-making at various levels of government. This project is planned for three years and will be implemented by UNDP in partnership with relevant national and international institutions.
