Brief: The objective of the Project is to finalise gender-based reviews of legislation with the overall objective to support the Government of Turkmenistan to formulate gender sensitive policies. The project will contribute to a legislative framework which effectively allows women and men to equitably contribute and benefit in the development process. To that end, the Project will contribute to important data, analysis and recommendations about men and women's rights, opportunities, obligations and challenges in different spheres of life, will be revised laws related to gender equality, and drafts prepared. The methodology used is grounded in UNDP's dual track approach to gender; focusing on assessing the implications of policy on men and women (gender mainstreaming).

The Project activities will include changes in legislation and designing of draft with strategic and legal recommendation for consideration in Parliament. Moreover, a range of legal and policy recommendations accompanied by awareness raising campaigns on gender and occupational segregation and events on attracting men and women to gender sensitive occupations conducted and supplemented with concrete training courses, seminars, round tables and educational programmes in gender and economics for teachers of secondary and professional schools of Turkmenistan.


