



ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

Amendment No. 1

Project Number: CFLI-2020-ANKRA-TK-0001

Project Name: Strengthening the capacity of the Ombudsperson's Office of Turkmenistan to protect human rights through workshops, promotion, and engagement with vulnerable groups.

These Articles of Amendment are made between Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada (referred to in this Amendment as "Her Majesty") represented by the Minister of Foreign Affairs (referred to in this Amendment as Department of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Development(**DFATD**)) and:

(Hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient" and jointly as the "Parties")

DFATD and the Recipient agree to amend the Contribution Agreement made as of 28/09/2020 as follows:

1. Page 13, Paragraph 4 (planned activities) will be deleted and replaced by:

Conducting information sessions on the work of the Ombudsperson's Office in the field of women's rights in three Resource Centers the velayats. (20 participants x 3 velayats). The sessions will be delivered by an expert from the Ombudsperson's Office (1 person), a national consultant (1 person), and 1 UNDP staff member. This activity is planned to be delivered in September 2021. As a result, knowledge of 60 women representatives from CSOs will be increased on the role and functions of the Ombudsperson's Office. Roundtables will be conducted at the Human Rights Resource Centers in Mary, Dashoguz, and Turkmenabad (20 women each).

2. Page 13, Paragraph 5 (planned activities) will be deleted and replaced by:

Conducting a seminar on the study of best practices in legal education in the field of human rights. Two-day seminar for the representatives of Ministry of Education, staff of the Ombudsmen Office, professors, and administration of the Institute of International Relations of MFA and/or International Humanitarian Studies University (1 international expert, online format, LOE 8 days). As a result of this activity, it is expected to develop the Recommendation for the Methodology to add a course on Human Rights to the curriculum. At this moment, there is no special course on Human Rights at the educational institutions.

3. Page 14, Paragraph 6 (planned activities) will be deleted and replaced

Conducting technical consultations with ATF experts on applying for accreditation to GANHRI.1.5 days seminar and "Round Table" - presentation of the Roadmap for obtaining accreditation in GANHRI. 1 International expert, online format, LOE 10 days. As a result of the roundtable the Final Draft of the Roadmap on accreditation in GANHRI will be developed

4. Page 17, section “5” named “Proposed Project Budget for Project” will be deleted and replaced by:
