Summary

The main objective of the project is strengthening of the protection, promotion and realization of human rights in Turkmenistan through harmonization of laws, politics and practice in accordance with the country's obligations that are derived from international treaties on human rights and the implementation of the National Human Rights Action Plan (NHRAP) of Turkmenistan for 2016-2020. Within the framework of given project, assistance to the Government of Turkmenistan is planned in the realization of the NHRAP 2016-2020 and designing a new Action Plan for 2021-2025, in accordance with the provisions of Turkmenistan's Constitution and the realization of the Turkmenistan's obligations, which were adopted by the country within the framework of the UPR and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) related to the area of human rights.

The project activities specified in this Annual Work Plan, will be aimed at supporting the Government in conducting evaluation of the NHRAP, learning international experience and capacity building in the field of UN treaty body reporting, implementation of UPR recommendations, development of the new NHRAP, and to awareness-raising on human rights among government agencies, public servants, students and public.
