GRANT AGREEMENT

between the International Labour Organization and the United Nations Development Programme

Whereas the International Labour Organization, represented by the International Labour Office (ILO), Decent Work Team and Office for the Caribbean, through its RB-slippage, which pursues the goal of funding a study on sexual harassment in the Government of Trinidad and Tobago; and

Whereas the proposal submitted by the **United Nations Development Programme** (the "Grantee") has been selected for the award of a grant on the terms set out in this grant agreement (in its final approved form, the "Grant Activity");

The ILO and the Grantee (the "Parties") agree as follows:

GRANT AWARD

I. Scope of the Agreement

- I.f. The following documents, listed in their order of precedence, conform the entire agreement between the Parties (the "Agreement") and supersede any prior oral or written agreements or communications between them on the matter:
 - Grant Award
 - General Terms and Conditions Applicable to ILO Grants (Annex A)
 - To fund a study on sexual harassment in the Government of Trinidad and Tobago

II. General Obligations

II.I. The ILO will provide the Grantee, subject to the ILO having received necessary funds from its donor(s), with a grant of 67,650 Trinidad and Tobago Dollars (TTD) (the "Grant"). Payment of the Grant will be made in one instalment as soon after the signature of this Agreement as practicable under the circumstances, by bank transfer in TT Dollars to the following bank account of the Grantee:

II.II The Grantee will use the Grant only for the Grant Activity, for contracting a consultant to undertake a study on sexual harassment in the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, in accordance with the Agreement]. The Grantee will carry out the Grant Activity with due diligence and efficiency. The Grantee agrees to use the grant funds only for the Project in the manner described in the Project Document (Annex A), subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, without prejudice to the ILO's constitutional mandate relating to international labour standards. Any changes in the scope or content of the Grant Activity must be agreed in writing between the Grantee and the ILO and appended to this Agreement.

II.III The Grantee shall be responsible for providing annual financial statements; the accuracy of such financial statements and any other reports may be subject to verification. Funds provided pursuant to this Agreement shall be used according to the Project Budget.

II.V. The Grant Activity will be performed from **28 September 2018** and will be completed by **31 December 2018** or other date fixed by any extension approved by the ILO (the "Grant Period"). Any funds unexpended from the Grant after completion of the Grant Activity will be disposed of in accordance with the ILO's instructions.²

- II.VI. No later than one month after the end of the Grant Period, the Grantee will submit to the satisfaction of the ILO:
 - a) a narrative report on the Grant Activity and use of the Grant; and
 - b) a certification attesting to the utilisation of the Grant in accordance with the Agreement.3
