1. <u>Issuance of Authorized Spending Limit (ASL)</u>: To facilitate a quick start to the PPG, once the Initiation Plan is signed, please kindly ensure that the Atlas-generated <u>Annual Work Plan (AWP)</u> based on the <u>Total Budget and Annual Work Plan</u> in the attached document, along with a copy of the signed cover page, is sent to <u>Mr. Maxim Vergeichik</u>, Regional Technical Advisor in Bratislava.

Any budget revisions should be forwarded to the UNDP-GEF Regional Coordination Unit (RCU) with an explanation of the changes proposed. In this connection, please note that UNDP-GEF is not in a position to increase the budget above the amount already approved by the GEF. Therefore, any over-expenditure during this initiation phase would have to be absorbed by other Country Office resources.

2. <u>GEF-specific project management requirements</u>:

 Any changes contemplated with respect to the project objectives and outcomes will have to be discussed with and approved by the UNDP-GEF RCU, as they will have to be reported to the GEF.

- The final submission of the *FSP* that is prepared with this preparation grant, must be accompanied by a "GEF PPG Status Report". The template can be obtained from the UNDP-GEF Programming Manual http://intra.undp.org/gef
- This preparatory phase must be operationally completed in Atlas once the main project is endorsed/approved by the GEF CEO. Financial closure should follow within 12 months, but preferably within the same calendar year.
