10. Brief Summary of the Mission:10A. Findings		
1. <u>TCAP Board Meeting</u> : The Minister of Finance, Seve Paeniu, is the new co-chair for the TCAP Board.		

He is also the GCF NDA for the government of Tuvalu. AWP for 2020, with a budget of USD\$8.7m has been approved. The Board were informed that the ESIA component of the Coastal assessment is currently being done by SPC which will ultimately inform the engineering design. Construction works is anticipated to commence in October of 2020. The Minister, in his capacity as co-chair echoed his

- sentiments on the need to increase the visibility of TCAP to all our stakeholders through having a sound communications strategy.
- 2. <u>Community Consultation</u> the Funafuti Kaupule and the Funafuti community were appraised on the approved interventions for Fogafale which is the foreshore reclamation from Queen Elizabeth Park (QEP) to Tausoa Beach covering a total area of 7.8hectares. They were also appraised on the outcome of the LIDAR airborne survey. The community have once again voiced their support for the reclamation works viewing it as an extremely beneficial investment for Funafuti. Some concerns were also raised on the rightful ownership of the newly reclaimed area.
- 3. <u>Community Training on the PBCRGS</u> (Grant system) the Funafuti Kaupule and community were also trained over 2 days on the Performance Based Grant System which they could qualify for provided they meet the minimum criteria and comply with the performance measures. Discussions also focused on areas TCAP will be providing assistance on to strengthen the capabilities of the Kaupule especially in planning, budgeting, reporting, etc
- 4. <u>Gender Strategy</u> together with our Gender consultant, Ms Aliti Vunisea, consultations were held with all our 5 government partners (DRD, CCD, PWD, DOE, DOLS). Other departments consulted included Ministry of Finance, Gender & Women's Department, Social Welfare Department, Waste Management Department, Fisheries Department, Statistics Department, TANGO, TNCW, Youth groups, Women's group, Nanumaga & Nanumea representatives living in Funafuti, R2R & FASNETT Projects.
- 5. <u>Gender Training</u> a 1day training was conducted at the end of the consultation and both the government stakeholders, NGO's and the community, including the youth groups) were well represented.
- 6. <u>Cancellation of Outer Island visit</u> the outer island consultation visits to both Nanumea and Nanumaga had to be cancelled at the 11th hour due to non-availability of a boat. This had to be deferred to mid-January 2020 as the inter-island ferries were confirmed to be available then.
