In view of compliance assessment as per table 2 above, it was observed that:

Hughes Motors Tanzania Ltd (bidder No.1) has quoted for CASE Brand, Model: 845B VHP Motor Grader hence does not comply fully with technical specification especially alternato intended for use in rather remote areas of Tanzania and this deviation is considered substantive since if the electrical part of the equipment fails, there will be no quick solutions arou money would be compromised.

MANTRAC Tanzania Ltd (bidder No.2) quoted for CAT Brand, Model: 140K Motor Grader. This model compiled with technical specifications included in the tender document. Fortunateb agency is currently using same brand which was acquired more that 10 years ago and has been functioning property without problem. Mantrac Tanzania Ltd has various service c Region which is adjacent to Ruaha National Park.

COMPRINT International Ltd (bidder No.3) quoted for an unnamed Brand and Model. The evaluation Team took time to review other technical specifications and also noted that the anot match completely with the one specified in the tender document. This bidder was considered non-responsive and dropped from further consideration.

In view of the above observations, it is obvious that only Mantrac Tanzania Ltd responded positively to all specifications provided in the tender document by quoting the most a environment. However, in order to further assess its appropriateness with other aspects, further analysis between Mantrac Tanzania Ltd and Hughes Motors Tanzania Ltd offers wall included in table 3 and 4.

Assessment of Procurement process

ITB was widely advertised on UNDP CO website, UNGM and local print medias from 27 June 2013 to 04 July 2013. Due to official visit of UNDP administrator to the country object to the US President to the United Republic of Tanzania, public bid opening session was postponed for 4 September 2013. All bidders were informed according rembership consisted of 3 UNDP staff members and 2 technical experts from TANAPA and project coordinator of SPANEST, participated in the evaluation process. 3 bids in the evaluation process. 3 bids in the evaluation process.

Assessment of Evaluation Process

The evaluation procedure consisted of a preliminary examination, followed by technical and financial evaluation. No bids were rejected during preliminary evaluation. During rejected at technical evaluation stage because the equipment offered did not comply with the requirement of a 95 Amp Alternator. The only responsive bidder Mantrac Tan analysis, Mantrac Tanzania was recommended for award.

Value for money

Effort to contact Mantrac Peadquarters located in United States of America and obtain factory price of the equipment was undertaken, even if provision of quotation was no tringa Municipal Council recently purchased similar equipment with the same specifications for USD 363,482.00. The same equipment is bought for less than USD 5,482.00 by Iringa Municipal Council 6 months ago. The price is inclusive of delivery of equipment to the respective site (about 600 kilometers from DaresSalaam), onsite training an to contact Mantrac Headquarters to benchmark the price were futile as the company referred the CO to the local firm Mantrac.

Assessment of Quality Assurance Mechanism

TANAPA who is the project's executing agency is currently using same brand for 10 years.

Delivery period is 5 weeks after receipt of Purchase Order. Bid Security has been provided the Organization (UNDP) for non delivery The road construction equipment (CA internationally recognized and ISO certified, it is covered by 12 months warranty terms. The price include delivery to the site and orientation to the users.

Assessment of Vendor qualifications

Mantrac Tanzania Limited is a sole dealer of Carterpillar equipments representing manufacturer based in United States of America whose Africa Regional Headquaters bas has been operating successfully in Tanzania for number of years and has been supplying Caterpillar Equipment to government Institutions and private construction compar network of service centers countrywide where after sales services and availability of spare parts is noted. Mantrac Tanzania Limited are financially sound.

Screening against UN Sanctions and Eligibility

The proposed vendors are neither in the Consolidated list of individuals and Entities with Association to Terrorist Organizations nor in the List of Vendors Suspended or Re Procurement Division Vendor Roster.

The CO has now provided the responses to all the RACP comments and the major highlights are as follows;

- 1. CO clarified that the consideration for specifying a 95 Amp alternator was based on engine size and rating speed.
- 2. An independent mechanical engineer has also certified that based on his experience a 95 Amp machine would be a more appropriate machine to purchase and has higher engine an
- 3. RACP had initial concerns on the specification of a 95 Amp alternator which resulted in only a Caterpillar machine being technically qualified. Further due diligence by RACP has reve alternator is not necessarily restrictive because there are other grader machines like John Deer which come with alternators of 100, 120 or 130 Amp. CO also established that one of t Amp alternator machine. See attached letter from Comprint, RACP therefore agreed that the specification of 95Amp is therefore not restrictive.
- 4. Committee had concerns with the composition of the evaluation team in which junior non technical UNDP staff members were part of the technical evaluation panel that included ser organization. A note to the file endorsed by the OCD/O explaining the circumstances on how the panel was constituted has been provided. Nonetheless CO Management should ensure properly constituted and if UNDP does not have the technical capacity then such expertise should be hired.
- 5. CO also clarified that even though the machine has been purchased locally UNDP will not be paying any customs duties and taxes.
- 6. The Procurement Officer is advised to be up to date with the latest corporate solicitation documents available on the intranet which were released last year.

The specifications appear to be biased towards CAT grader. i) Please clarify the basis of specifying precisely a 95 Ampere Alternator when design and engineering practices are different in the world.

ii) Why not specify a range of Amperage acceptable, iii) Hughes Motors equipment could not meet ONLY the 95 Amp Alternator requirement but the reasons given in evaluation report why this deviation was not acceptable were all non technical. Evaluation report stated that * ...this deviation is considered substantive since if the electrical part of the equipment fails, there will be no quick solutions around...* (a) does this mean an 80 Amp Alternator breaks down easily compared to a 95 Amp alternator? The reasons given here are not sound at all.

iv) Please provide a proper technical explanation from an independent Mechanical Engineer to confirm that a grader with an 80Amp Alternator cannot perform the same as a grader with 95Amp alternator.

The evaluation of provision of services after sales (Table No 3) is very subjective and does not appear to be based on information from the bids themselves but from the panel's own judgements against Hughes Motors. They have indicated that a service will be provide in Arusha (Head Quarters) and Dar es Salaam (to opened soon -- under construc The technical bid has been uploaded. The motor grader will be operated in Ruaha National Parks which 900 kilometers from Arusha. On the other hand, Mantrac Tanzania Limited has service centres countryw including one in Iringa, the closest to Ruaha National Park.

Although these criteria were not included in the ITB but both Mantrac and Hughes did provide the inform which was easily compared. This was done purely to assess the capacity of the equipment especially the clearance because equipment will be used in remote area where roads are rough. It should be noted that criteria were not used to disqualify Hughes and qualify Mantrac in this case.

The Team from Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA) and SPANEST participated as non-voting members I provided technical guidance to ensure that the customer requirement and satisfaction are fully met.
