Justification for Substantive Project Revision

The Support to National Human Rights Priorities comes to an end on 30 June 2015. The project has progressed far towards achieving the identified deliverables. In order to further progress and ensure sustainability of the achievements it is proposed, following discussion between UNDP and CHRAGG, to have a no-cost extension of the project to 31 December 2015 to achieve the following deliverables:
