Justification for Substantive Project Revision

The Support to Zanzibar Anti-Corruption project comes to an end on 30 June 2015. The project has progressed far towards achieving the identified deliverables, but key activities in the implementation of the project have been delayed. The delay is related to postponement of attachment of ZACECA staff to PCCB and procurement of international consultant to conduct sector specific anti-corruption assessment. Following discussion between UNDP and ZACECA at a project monitoring visit 27 May and subsequent follow-up it proposed to have a no-cost extension of the project to 31 December 2015 to complete the following deliverables:

- Support attachment of key ZACECA staff to PCCB Mainland Tanzania;
- Assessment, action plan and M&E framework for sector specific approach to anti-corruption;
- Finalize activities related to capacity building and public awareness raising.
