Addendum 1

To the Cost-Sharing Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Finland and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) regarding the reallocation of the unutilised balances of Finland's contribution from the ESP to DEP

- 1. The Government of the Republic of Finland (hereafter referred to as the 'Donor'), and the United Nations Development Programme (hereinafter referred to as UNDP) have concluded in 2009 a Cost-Sharing Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the Main Agreement) for Finland's contribution to the project 'Election Support Project' (hereinafter referred to as ESP).
- 2. UNDP has indicated the balance to Finland's ESP contribution amounting to USD 957, 927 and has requested for the transfer of these funds to ESP's successor project 'Democratic Empowerment Project' (DEP), award number 00068932.
- 3. Following recent communication between the parties:
 - a) Finland has agreed to reinvest ESP unutilised balances to implement planned activities for the Democratic Empowerment Project (DEP) as outlined in the Project Document and that UNDP will submit a report to Finland by the mutually agreed timeframe, as stipulated in the DEP project document (attached hereto as Annex 1), UNDP's proposal for Finland (attached hereto as Annex 2), and other documentation related to the project.
 - b) As outlined in Article XI of the Main Agreement 'The agreement may be amended through an exchange of letters between the Donor and UNDP. The letters exchanged to this effect shall become an integral part of the Agreement.'
- 4. All other terms of the Main Agreement remain unchanged and valid. This addendum will place on record our common understanding of the above change and will enter into force on the date both parties sign their confirmation below.
