**6. Purpose of the mission:**  
To attend and monitor organization of ‘SDGs Awareness Workshops’ in Micheweni, Pemba.

**7. Summary of the Workshops**  
Pursuant to strengthening multi-stakeholder partnerships for sustainable development, ANGOZA in collaboration with the Zanzibar Planning Commission organized 2 workshops in Micheweni Pemba on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> March 2019. The workshops funded by UNDP under the auspices of the Zanzibar Joint Program, were aimed at creating awareness of local leaders, community and religious leaders as well as CSOs, on MKUZA III and SDGs, with the view of enabling them to further advocate for implementation of MKUZA III and Agenda 2030 at grassroot levels in their respective communities.

- i. The workshop held on 7th March 2019, mainly focused on local leaders, community and religious leaders from various shehias of Micheweni, District. A total of 63 participants and facilitators (18 female and 45 male) participated in the workshop.
- ii. The workshop held on 8th March 2019, was for representatives of CSOs, community development groups and local authorities from Micheweni mainly aimed at creating their awareness on SDGs and formation of SDGs CSO platforms to support awareness campaigns at grass root levels. A total of 67 participants and facilitators (30 female and 37 male) participated in the workshop.

In their opening remarks representatives of ANGOZA and ZPC highlighted the importance of the workshops and acknowledged the support of UNDP. UNDP’s representative underscored the role of community, religious and CSO leaders in creating awareness of Agenda 2030 and MKUZA III in their respective communities, so as to ensure that ‘no one is left behind’ in the development process. It was also brought to their attention that such forums are opportunities for the leaders to prioritize their development challenges, for further consideration in the development plans of their respective shehias and district.

The following papers were presented at both workshops:

- i. An overview of SDGs and MKUZA III, and the role of the various religious, community and CSO leaders in creating awareness and implementation of SDGs and MKUZA III.
- ii. Relationship between SDGs to MKUZA III and their implementation.
- iii. Voluntary National Review process.

**8. Key Issues Discussed**

Group discussions, acknowledged measures taken in implementing the SDGs and MKUZA III, in particular in addressing gender disparities in leadership and decision-making positions, as well as improved education and health services. However, the following issues were raised: limited awareness of SDGs within the community; prevalence of high levels of poverty; lack of information on the implementation status of the SDGs; weakness of public institutions in addressing governance and corruption cases; spillover effects of industrialization and environmental degradation from developed and neighboring countries; and need for quality education. Priority SDGs goals identified include: 1, 3, 4, 6, 15, and 16.

The second day group discussions culminated in formation of four SDGs CSO platforms for Micheweni District. The platforms were based on specific MKUZA III KRAs and corresponding SDGs (Annex 1).

**9. Recommendations**

- i. In recognition of the importance of the workshop in creating their awareness on SDGs and MKUZA III, similar awareness workshops are to be organized in all districts.
- ii. Community leaders in collaboration with CSOs to prepare action plans towards implementation of priority SDGs.
- iii. The SDGs platform are to work closely with Office of District Council in implementation, monitoring and reporting of SDGs at district level.
- iv. Wards, Council and Shehia Consultative meetings should consider SDGs in their respective plans.

**10. Key Actions to be taken include:**

Support roll out of SDGs and MKUZA III awareness campaigns, in all 11 districts of Zanzibar.
