Brief Description

This project aims at supporting implementation of early adaptation actions for local communities that are adversely affected by climate change impacts in selected areas of Tanzania. The project also focuses on demonstrating successful community based climate change adaptation initiatives to transform productive capacities for resilient livelihoods of the poor and excluded. The basic idea is to improve people's livelihoods through reducing vulnerabilities and increasing climate change resilience. The project objective will be achieved by equipping the communities with knowledge and technologies, which are appropriate for combating impacts of climate change on agricultural productivity, food security, water availability and rangelands.

Project Extension:

Following successful completion of this project on 31 December 2015 and need to promote financial sustainability of the supported actions, the project is extended for 1 year up to 31 December 2016. During the extension period, successful CSOs that implemented CBA initiatives under this project will be invited through a competitive process to present proposals that will facilitate completion of the value chain of their actions and promote financial sustainability through market transformation. A total of USD 750,000 has been added to support the extension phase.
