Brief Description

The Uganda Diaspora is a powerful resource for the country, but there are challenges hindering their maximum contribution to national development. H.E. President of the Republic of Uganda Yoweri Kaguta Museveni directed, in 2007, the MoFA to take the lead role in offering a comprehensive range of services to the large population of Uganda Diaspora to facilitate their contribution to the country's social, economic, technological and political development. This project is therefore aimed at creating an enabling environment that fosters the diaspora contributions and thereby lead to growth and socio-economic transformation for prosperity, which is a key anchor of the National Development Plan (NDP). The project will focus on interventions in three areas: i) strengthening the MoFA information and management systems for greater coordination and strategic partnerships with the diaspora; ii) developing policy and institutional arrangements for guiding diaspora participation and contribution to national development and iii) enhancing incentives for diaspora investments and remittances as well as identifying opportunities for national development so as to guide diaspora investment.
